The Kingdom of Cambodia has received a loan and a grant from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) toward the cost of Climate-Friendly Agribusiness Value Chains Sector Project (CFAVC), and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this Loan and Grant to payments under the Contracts for **the Supply, Delivery, and Installation of Equipment & Materials for 15 Drip Irrigation Demonstrations for 15 Mango Production Sites at Kampot, Kampong Cham, Tboung Khmum, and Takeo provinces**, IFB No.: G3/CFAVC/MAFF/NCB/2025.

2. The Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the Supply, Delivery, and Installation of Equipment & Materials for 15 Drip Irrigation Demonstrations for 15 Mango Production Sites at Kampot, Kampong Cham, Tboung Khmum, and Takeo provinces. The construction period is 180 calendar days after signing contract.
3. Procurement will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding Procedures specified in the RGC's Standard Operating Procedures on Procurement for All Externally Financed Projects/Program, under the laws and regulations governing public procurement within the Kingdom of Cambodia an in accordance with the Financing Agreement and Procurement Regulations of Asian Development Bank.
4. This invitation is open to all eligible bidders from eligible source countries as described in the Bidding Document.
5. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00 am to 12:00 and 2:00 to 5:00 pm on all working days.
6. Qualification requirements include (key technical, financial, legal, and other qualifications as specified in ITB Sub-Clause 14.2 (c) of the bidding documents):
- (i) The bidder has satisfactorily completed at least two contracts for supply of similar goods in the preceding last three years of not less than **USD 404,000**.
 - (ii) The bidder has completed contracts for the total cumulative amount equal to at leas **USD 1,620,000** in the last two years.
 - (iii) The Manufacturer of the offered goods, if a different entity from the Bidder, has experience of at least 3 years in the manufacturing of similar goods.
 - (iv) The bidder has availability of liquid assets through either:

- a) access to a line of credit or cash in bank account of an amount at least **USD 404,000**; Or
 - b) credit terms with vendors specifically for the goods to be supplied under the contract, and valid for at least 6 months after the deadline date for submission of bids specified in ITB Clause 21.
7. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address given below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **50 US Dollars** or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel being **200,000.00 Riels**. The method of payment will be in cash. The Bidding Documents will be sent thorough email in PDF format and may be collected in person. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for purchase of the bidding documents.

The Government and/or the Asian Development Bank will respectively declare a bidder ineligible either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract participate in activities financed, administered or supported by them, or to benefit from a contract financed, administered or supported by them, financially or otherwise, if at any time they determine that the bidder has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, or fraudulent, coercive, collusive or obstructive practices or other integrity violations in competing for or in executing the contract.
