REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST
FOR
FEASIBILITY STUDY AND DETAILED DESIGN CONSULTANTS, PACKAGE NO. CS10-FSDD-AF

1. The Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) has received a Loan and Grant from the Asian Development (ADB) towards the cost of Irrigated Agriculture Improvement Project and Additional Financing executed by the Ministry of Water Resources and Meteorology.
2. The Ministry of Water Resources and Meteorology to apply a portion of these loans and grants for engaging international consulting firm for Feasibility Study And Detailed Design Consultants, Package No. CS10-FSDD-AF. The consulting firm is expected to mobilize in December 2026 and cover for a period of 12 months with a total of 367 person-months (p-m), of which 25 p-m will be international experts and 342 person-months for national experts.
3. The main scope and duration of the Feasibility Study and Detailed Design (FSDD) consulting services are to undertake (i) pre-feasibility study of the Tvaruk subproject; (ii) feasibility studies of the Charek, Tvaruk, Sre Anteak, Thnol Bot, and Prey Kpous subprojects, including undertaking all necessary surveys and assessments to support ADB's due diligence requirements; (iii) a market assessment for public-private partnership opportunities for construction, operation and management of the PDN systems; (iv) for detailed engineering designs, detailed cost estimates, and to prepared the bidding documents for those subprojects which will be constructed under the SIWRMP; and (v) for conducting consultative workshops for each subproject, as well as management reporting.
4. Following on from the IAIP and the IWRMP, the proposed project will embrace next-generation modernization features, including, for example: (i) buried pipe distribution network (PDN) systems, (ii) modern canal systems designed to work with PDN systems, (iii) electrification and solar power, (iv) water storages, groundwater and/ or conjunctive use, (v) flood protection, (vi) drainage, (vii) all-weather inspection/ access roads, (viii) digital management systems including SCADA/ telemetry, and (ix) measures to support sustainable operation and maintenance, and for take-up of higher value crops, and so on.
5. The Ministry of Water Resources and Meteorology now invites interested international consulting firm who is suitably qualified and experienced, to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) for the said consulting service. The consultant selection will be Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS:80:20) method as described in the ADB Procurement Policy, Procurement Regulations for ADB Borrowers, and User's Guide on the Selection of Consulting Services for Borrowers.
