

Invitation for Bids

Upgrade of Public Landing Sites in Koh Kong Province (Chamkar Loeu and Koh Kyang Landing Sites in Sre Ambell Bay, Koh Kong)

1. The Royal Government of Cambodia (RGC) has received a loan and a grant from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) for Sustainable Coastal and Marine Fisheries Project (SCMF), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the Contract for the **Upgrade of Public Landing Sites in Koh Kong Province (Chamkar Loeu and Koh Kyang Landing Sites in Sre Ambell Bay Koh Kong)**.
2. The Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF) through its Project Management Unit (PMU) in the Fisheries Administration (FiA) now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the **Upgrade of Public Landing Sites in Koh Kong Province (Chamkar Loeu and Koh Kyang Landing Sites in Sre Ambell Bay Koh Kong) (contract no. SCMFP FIA/CW-04a)**. The construction period is 540 calendar days from the date of notification to commence. The Bidder evaluation and qualification criteria are included in Section II of the bidding document.
3. Procurement will be conducted through National Competitive Bidding Procedures specified in the RGC's Standard Operating Procedures on Procurement for All Externally Financed Projects, under the laws and regulations governing public procurement within the Kingdom of Cambodia, and in accordance with the Financing Agreement and Procurement Regulations of the ADB.
4. This invitation is open to all qualified bidders from eligible source countries of as described in the Bidding Document.
5. Bidders' attention is drawn to Sub-Clause 6.3 of the Instructions to Bidders (ITB) on the Qualification requirements. Qualification requirements include:
 - The average annual volume of construction work of the successful bidder over the last three years (2023, 2024, and 2025) shall be at least **US\$ 6,500,000**.
 - The bidder has substantially or successfully completed, as prime contractor, at least two similar contracts in size and nature within the last five (5) years (from 1st March 2021 to the bid submission deadline, to comply with this requirement, works cited should be at least 70% complete, billed and paid) with contractual value of each contract of not less than **US\$ 3,300,000**. The similarity of the works experience shall include: construction of reinforced concrete structures.
 - The minimum amount of liquid assets and/or credit facilities net of other contractual commitments of the successful Bidder shall be at least **US\$ 750,000**.
 - For Cambodian Bidders: valid registration from the Ministry of Commerce (MOC), and Land Management Urban Planning and Construction (LMUPC), and a valid registration/permit /patent issued by the Ministry of Economy and Finance (MEF).
 - Bidders with duly audited financial statements by an independent firm, for the last three (3) years (2023, 2024, and 2025) demonstrating soundness of its financial position. As a minimum, the Bidder's net worth for the last three (3) years calculated as the difference between total assets and total liabilities should be positive. The financial statements and its audit should not violate the relevant national statutory accounting standards.

The qualification criteria are more completely described in the Sub Clause 6.3 and 6.1(h) of the Instructions to Bidders in the Bidding Documents including essential equipment and key personnel.

6. A complete set of Bidding Documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address given below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **50 USD** or its equivalent in Cambodian Riel being **200,000.00 Riel**. The method of payment will be by cash. The Bidding Documents will be sent by email in PDF format or may be collected in person at the discretion of the bidder. Other than payment of the non-refundable fee specified above, there shall be no other conditions for purchase of the bidding documents.

Bids will be immediately opened after the deadline for submission of bid in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend in person at the address below at **3.00 pm on 08 April 2026** (Cambodia Standard Time).
10. All bids shall be accompanied by a **Bid Securing Declaration** as described in the ITB.
11. The Government and Asian Development Bank will respectively declare a firm ineligible either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract funded by them, if they at any time determine that the firm has engaged in fraud and corruption as described in ITB 3.
